#### Cold and Flu Season

The peak of cold and flu season is quickly approaching. To prevent widespread flu and other respiratory illnesses in Adult Day, we recommend your loved one stays home if they are experiencing symptoms of illness. To decide whether or not to bring your loved one to Adult Day, please consider the following guidelines:

Keep your loved one at home for treatment and observation if he or she has any of these symptoms:

- Very stuffy or runny nose and/or cough
- Mild sore throat (no fever, no known exposure to strep)
- Headache
- Stomach ache
- Fever (greater than 100 degrees). Your loved one can only return after his or her temperature has been consistently below 100 degrees, by mouth, for a minimum of 24 hours
- Vomiting (even once)
- Diarrhea
- Chills

- General feelings of fatigue, discomfort, weakness or muscle aches
- Frequent congested (wet) or croupy cough

To help prevent the flu and other colds, please encourage the following healthy hygiene habits:

- Wash hands frequently
- Do not touch eyes, nose, or mouth
- Cover mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing, use a paper tissue, throw it away, and then wash hands
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Get plenty of sleep, be physically active, manage your stress, drink plenty of fluids, and eat nutritious food.

Keeping your loved one home while they are sick will minimize the spread of infections and viruses at Adult Day. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### **Nurses Notes**

### Medical Changes and Medications

Medical conditions can change quickly, and we would like to be able to continuously meet the needs of your loved one. If there are any changes in medications, diagnoses, or dietary changes, please let us know as soon as possible. We may need a physician's order to

accommodate the needs of your loved one. Any medications given in Adult Day must be accompanied by:

- A script from the physician (similar to the one they send to the pharmacy)
- The medications also need to be in the original bottle with a label from the pharmacy (this label must match the script).





If your loved one requires medication that is routinely administered at Adult Day, we are able to keep a supply of medication locked in our medication cart.
